Matters Arising:

- 1. It was agreed to discuss waste collection facilities at the next meeting.
- 2. The councillors agreed to consider the need for reflective bollards at the junction of Church Road and South Walsham Road.
- **3.** The clerk was asked to clarify the health and safety requirements for volunteers working in the village.

Correspondence:

- 1. Broadland District Council sent details of the consultation on the Community Infrastructure Levy. This will not affect the village as no market housing is planned for the parish.
- 2. Norwich Diocese has sent notification that there will be a review of the allotment rent.
- 3. The clerk was asked to contact Keith Simpson MP to ask that the dualling of the A47 at North Burlingham be reconsidered following the recent accident.
- 4. Broadland District Council has sent notice that the delegated function of monitoring the street cleaning will cease from March 2012.
- 5. Norfolk County Council sent an update on the Better Broadband scheme. Residents will be asked to register their interest in a better service from the New Year. This will be advertised in the Mardler and perhaps via a leaflet drop.
